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Gillespie County Rest Areas

The rest area buildings consist of wood framed roofs supported by exposed custom wood trusses, load-bearing concrete masonry walls and concrete slab-on-grade foundations. Exterior cladding consists of limestone veneer and glass block windows, with galvanized steel roofs.

The storage building and monument sign can be seen beyond the picnic arbor. Picnic arbors were constructed using galvanized tube steel frames with limestone veneer and galvanized steel roofs.
